

COLLOQUIUM (COLQ)

COLQ 2991. Humanities Colloquium. (2 Credits)

Prerequisite: ENGL 1102 and additional prerequisites stated in the current schedule book. Credit Hours: (2-0-2). A colloquium on selected topics in the humanities emphasizing the development of critical thinking skills.

COLQ 2992. Nat Sci/Math Colloquium. (2 Credits)

Prerequisite: ENGL 1102 and additional prerequisites stated in the current schedule book. Credit Hours: (2-0-2). A colloquium on selected topics in the natural sciences, mathematics, computer science, or allied health professions, emphasizing the development of critical thinking skills.

COLQ 2993. Social Science Colloquium. (2 Credits)

Prerequisite: ENGL 1102 and additional prerequisites stated in the current schedule book. Credit Hours: (2-0-2). A colloquium on selected topics in the social sciences and social science methodologies emphasizing the development of critical thinking skills.

COLQ 2994H. Honors Colloquium. (2 Credits)

Prerequisite: ENGL 1102 and additional prerequisites stated in the schedule book. Credit Hours: (2-0-2). A course intended for students to explore and examine the ideal question of the whole person through writing and discussion of various texts in a seminar format. The course will be interdisciplinary and will emphasize reading, discussion, critical thinking skills and research from different academic disciplines. Students, in their quest for wholeness as persons, can explore their world both locally and globally while realizing their responsibilities as evolving individuals.

COLQ 2995. Global Perspectives. (3 Credits)

Prerequisite: ENGL 1102 and HIST 1121 or HIST 1122 and additional prerequisites stated in the current schedule book. Credit Hours: (3-0-3). Students will engage in a comparative analysis of political, social, economic, or institutional developments across the globe.
