

# FRENCH (FREN)

**FREN 1001. Elem French I. (3 Credits)**

Prerequisite: None Credit Hours: (3-0-3) An introduction to listening, speaking, reading, and writing in French and to the culture of French-speaking regions. Students who are determined by the instructor to be fluent in French through previous schoolwork or experience must take FREN 1002.

**FREN 1002. Elem French II. (3 Credits)**

Prerequisite: FREN 1001, two years of high school French, or permission of the instructor. Credit Hours: (3-0-3) A continuation of FREN 1001, including listening, speaking, reading, and writing in French and further study of the culture of French-speaking regions.

**FREN 2001. Intermediate French I. (3 Credits)**

Prerequisite for FREN 2001: FREN 1002 or permission of the instructor.  
Prerequisite for FREN 2002: FREN 2001 Credit Hours: (3-0-3) An extensive reading of authentic literary works in French, review of troublesome aspects of French syntax, and introduction to composition and literary discussion in French.

**FREN 2002. Intermediate French II. (3 Credits)**

Prerequisite: FREN 2001 Credit Hours: (3-0-3) An extensive reading of authentic literary works in French, review of troublesome aspects of French syntax, and introduction to composition and literary discussion in French.
